Post-Storm RTA Service Updates

What: Following Barry, full RTA bus and ferry service has been restored. The majority of streetcar lines are also back in service.

Service along the Riverfront line (via #47/48) ends at Harrah's, because a floodgate remains closed. The St. Charles line will be closed from S. Carrollton Ave. and Claiborne Ave. to St. Charles Ave. and Jena St., due to overhead catenary system (OCS) repairs that will start, this week.

When: Monday, July 15th • 10 AM

Where: #12 St. Charles
Service from S. Carrollton Ave. & Claiborne Ave. to St. Charles Ave. & Jena St will be suspended until OCS pole repairs are completed. The work is expected to wrap-up mid-September and will not affect traffic. Instead, bus service will be provided along this portion of the line.

#47/48 Canal
Service between Harrah's and French Market Station will be temporarily suspended due to a closed flood gate along the Riverfront. Service will still be provided from Harrah's to Cemeteries and City Park.

All other bus, streetcar, and ferry lines are back in service.
