


## **Registration with the Supplier Portal**

- New financial platform launched in June 2019.
- New platform for supplier management, bidding opportunities, PO and contract, invoice submission, and payment release.
- The Supplier Portal is the external interface of BRASS with individuals and entities who wish to do business with the City.

Enrolled suppliers are viewed as possible sources; however, enrollment does not guarantee your automatic inclusion as a bidder/respondent for all applicable solicitations.



What do departments, boards, and commissions buy?

### Range of purchases:

- Citywide: office supplies, computers, copiers, uniforms, business cards, building repairs, copy paper, janitorial services, vehicles repairs.
- Majority: security, maintenance supplies.
- Minority: medical supplies, ammunition.
- Rare: airplane parts, radiation detection equipment.

### • Types of purchases:

- Materials and supplies: all departments, boards and commissions.
- Services: Professional (architect, lawyer) or Non-Professional (janitorial, security).
- Construction: Capital Project Administration (building), Public Works (roads), Property Management (city facilities), NORD (recreational centers), New Orleans Public Library (branches).

What Will You Find On The Supplier Portal?

### • Methods of Procurement

- Invitation to Quote INFORMAL
  - Informal solicitation to purchase goods and non-professional services with a budget of less than \$20,000.
- Invitation to Bid ITB
  - Formal solicitation to purchase goods and non-professional services with a budget of \$20,000 or more.
- Request for Proposals RFP
  - Formal solicitation to hire a professional services provider with a budget of \$15,000 or more.
- Request for Qualifications RFQ
  - Formal solicitation to hire an architect or engineer on qualifications with a budget of \$15,000 or more.
- Other:
  - Request for Information RFI
    - To gather information and/or interest for upcoming opportunities.

- Select Commodity Codes
- Read everything
- Ask questions
- Do not wait until the last minute
- Research the prior procurement and/or contract
- Monitor the notifications for any modification of the solicitation
- Use the City's forms
- Check your math
- Include all required documentation
