Fares are available for purchase on the Le Pass app (norta.com/lepass), in person at the RTA's Canal Street facility located at 2817 Canal Street between 8:30 AM-4:30 PM, and online for delivery at norta.com/store. Passes are also available at select metro-area Walgreens stores. See norta.com/retailers for locations.

Cash Change

Bus and streetcar fareboxes accept up to a \$20 bill or RTA Tokens and only provide change with an RTA change card good for future rides on RTA. No cash refunds or cash change is available on any of the RTA modes. RTA highly encourages the use of the Le Pass app or Transit app for purchasing passes and fares for all modes.

Event Detours

Thursday, February 6

The following additional detours will be in effect for February 6th:


- Basin will be completely closed between Canal and Conti
- All buses will be detoured to avoid Elk and Canal
- All routes coming from the East and Downriver will detour using Claiborne to Tulane to access the main library hub.
- Routes 3, 61, and 62 will have a stop relocation to the main library on Tulane.
- Streetcars will stay in regular service, but will bypass the stop at Canal and Rampart from 2pm until the end of the night.

Super Bowl Parade

Saturday, February 8
Detours begin at 8am

The following routes will detour:

- 12-St Charles Streetcar service will end at Erato
- 47/48-Canal Streetcar service will end at N. Liberty
- 11-Magazine will detour to reach the main library and miss stops between Calliope and Canal
- 80-Desire/Louisa service will end at St Claude and Elysian Fields

These detours will be in effect until the parade route is cleared.

Super Bowl

Sunday, February 9
Detours begin at 10am

BUS DETOURS:

Bus routes will stop before reaching downtown to avoid congestion and tailgating activities around the Superdome.

- All buses coming from Bywater, Gentilly, Mid-City, and N.O. East (8, 32, 55, 61, 62, 84) will drop passengers off and turn around at the Main Library Hub.
- The 114A/B-GardenOaks/Sullen and 11-Magazine will drop passengers off and turn around at the Union Passenger Terminal (UPT).
- The 103-General Meyer will not cross the river and will end at Wilty Terminal. It will service the Algiers Ferry Terminal every 30 minutes to line up with the ferry.

- Routes that usually pass through downtown (51, 52, 57, 91) will be split, with the uptown portion ending at Union Passenger Terminal, and the downriver portion ending at the Main Library Hub.

Riders needing to travel through downtown should expect major delays and additional transfers. You are encouraged to use unaffected routes, if available, to reach your destinations (9, 27, 31).

STREETCAR DETOURS:

- The 49 UPT-Riverfront streetcar will only be running along the riverfront from the Canal St. Ferry Terminal and the French Market.
- The 46 UPT-Rampart streetcar will not be running.
- The 12 St. Charles streetcar will turn around at Harmony Circle
