Scope of Work Bay doors Preventative Maintenance/Repairs

Contractors should provide all material, furnish all labor and services specified in the contract including permits necessary for maintenance (where conditions warrant, adjust, lubricate, repair or replace the mechanical and electrical parts) of the type of bay doors listed and related equipment located in the facility specified in accordance with the specifications. All work is to be performed during regular working hours and on the regular working days of the bay doors unless otherwise specified.

UNLOADING & STORAGE: All unloading and storage of equipment purchased is the responsibility of the purchaser unless otherwise specified

INSTALLATION: Unless otherwise noted, factory-trained non-union workers should carry out all installations.

If possible, please include cover handling and disposing of existing equipment if installation entails removing it to pricing sheet.

DOCK LEVELERS: Pit forming is an option that can be quoted and supplied as needed.

If applicable, the cost of installation will need to cover supplies, offloading into a pre-formed pit, placement, shimming, and welding for pit levelers only.

ELECTRICAL: All wire, wiring, conduit, electrical hookup, control wiring, mounting of control panels and outside lights (if applicable) should be performed by contractors.

Project Deliverable: Overhead Bay Doors equipment should be examined for optimum operation. Examinations should cover the following but not limited to....

- Schedule of PM activities (monthly, quarterly, annually)
- Manufacturer's recommendations & compliance
