



SURVEY RESULTS

- Conducted 7/31 9/20
- 327 responses
 - Primarily collected at stops and on buses
- 70% ride almost every day
- Responses by zip code
 - 70114: 51%
 - 70131: 33%
 - Other: 16%





How would you rate the current bus service in your neighborhood?




What are the top 3 things that would make bus service better for you? (Choose up to 3)






JOB ACCESS VIA TRANSIT AT 7:00 AM

A year-long average of 2024 daily boardings and alightings across the RTA system. Stops with multiple lines are aggregated to one value.


