

Slide 14 - Poll - "What is your preferred route for Segment 1?"




- Participant comments:

## Slide 17 - Potential Routes - Segment


- Participant comments:


- Participant comments:

"Overlay the existing routes."


## Slide 29 – Travel Time: New Orleans East to Downtown
